

IDN Fast Track Review

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Ministry of Transport, Information Technology and Communications

“бг” TLD in the Fast Track

- ✓ **18 June 2008** - Bulgaria has requested the registration of a Cyrillic top level domain (бг) from ICANN in a Fast Track process
- ✓ **12 October 2009** - testing the Online Request System for IDN ccTLD FT
- ✓ **December 2009** - public consultation on the new Cyrillic string for Bulgaria and its management
- ✓ **January 2010** – Round table - local internet community insisted to submit our formal request for “бг”
- ✓ **19 February 2010** – submission of the request to consider the string “бг” for delegation as IDN ccTLD
- ✓ **19 March 2010** - the test request has passed the Request Completeness Validation and moved to the Linguistic Process Validation
- ✓ **6 April 2010** - the Linguistic Process Validation has been completed and the request is moved to the DNS Stability Panel for review
- ✓ **18 May 2010** - notification that DNS Stability Evaluation for “бг” is not successful



After the rejection

- » to make changes to the originally requested string
- » to submit an entirely new request



Problems

- » **Lack of clear and detailed motivation from the DNS Stability Panel about its decision to reject the string**
- » **Lack of objection/re-evaluation procedure**

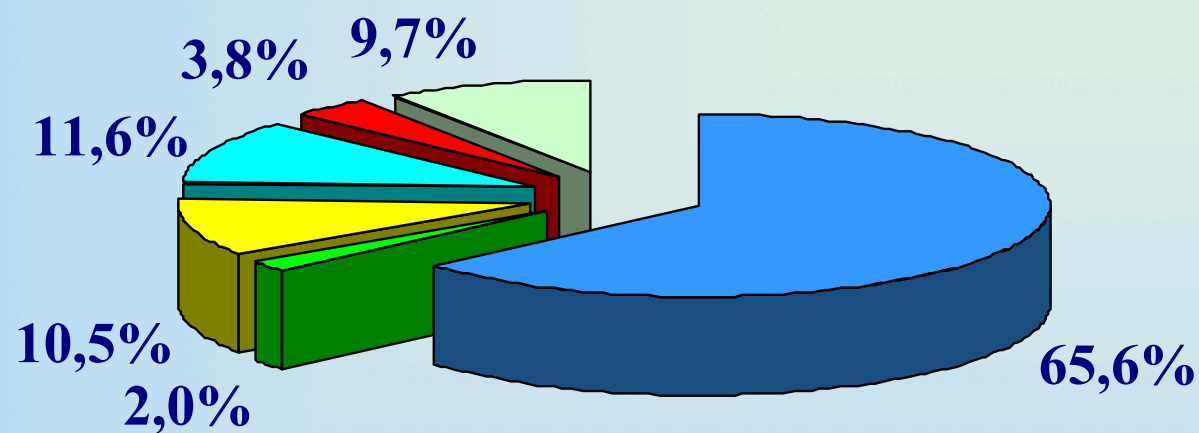
